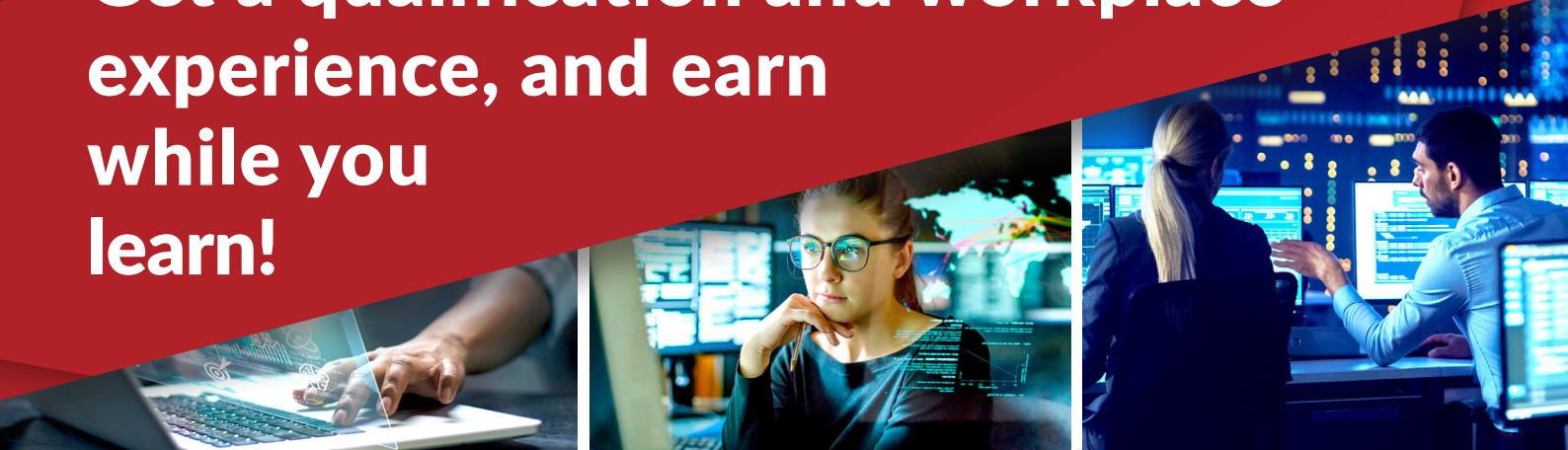

Nationally recognised training

This qualification will teach you the key concepts of cyber security; with a focus on identifying, mitigating, protecting from and defending against potential and actual cyber attacks. You'll learn protocols for authentication and encryption; software and network scripting; professional ethics; security data research and analysis; and much more! Your training will include hands on experience dealing with cyber security issues and attacks in a simulated technical environment, where you'll use the very latest technologies, strategies and techniques to attack and defend against cyber threats in real life scenarios.
